The Jan Juc Surf Life Saving Club is a 100% volunteer run organisation and depends entirely on membership, fundraising and donations to keep lifesavers on the beach and deliver our leading education and training programs.

The Jan Juc Surf Life Saving Club was founded in 1963 and continues to serve the communities of Jan Juc, Torquay and surrounds. With over 1250 members, Jan Juc SLSC is solely responsible for patrolling Jan Juc Beach.

The Jan Juc SLSC is largely self-funded via four major events – the Grand Final Eve Luncheon, the Golf Classic, the Bells Bash Cliff Run and the Danger Ocean Swim Series. The entire Club comes together to stage these events which are the major fundraisers for the Club.

Our club has a rich and successful history in all areas of competition at both a state and national level. Our success branches from Patrol and Lifesaving, Pool Lifesaving and Rescue and all areas of Surf Life Saving Competition. Our Club consistently performs well in Victorian patrol proficiency competitions and our training and education programs are among the best in the state, ensuring some of the very best surf lifesavers are looking after our beach and community.

Our Surf Education Program is one of the best in the State, teaching children aged 6 to 12 surf awareness, surf safety, basic first aid and rescue techniques. It not only teaches children how to look after themselves in an aquatic environment, but also how to assist someone else who may be in difficulty. They learn how to spot the dangers of the surf, such as rips and waves and also have fun competing in surf lifesaving sports such as swim and board races, beach flags, beach relays and beach sprints. Some children use this program as a holiday program, but many continue on to become qualified surf lifesavers, giving back to the Club and the Community.

Associate Requires WWCC for 18+ years. Patrolling and awards NOT required. No competition rights. Full voting rights for 18+ years. Access to club facilities, equipment, subsidised fitness & award training.	\$120
Community (Social) WWCC not required. Patrolling and awards NOT required. No competition rights. No voting rights. Access to bar only. No access to other club facilities, equipment, subsidised fitness or award training.	\$60
Junior (BM) 15-17 years as at 30-09-21. Requires BM and to nominate for at least 6 patrol shifts. Competition fees not included. No voting rights. Access to club facilities, equipment, subsidised fitness & award training.	\$100
Junior (SRC) 13-14 years as at 30-09-21. Requires SRC and to nominate for at least 6 patrol shifts. Competition fees not included. No voting rights. Access to club facilities, equipment, subsidised fitness & award training.	\$100
Nipper (Age Group) 6-12 years as at 30-09-21. Competition fees not included. No voting rights. Access to club facilities, equipment, subsidised fitness & award training. Includes Nipper Pack, entry to either the Junior Juc Bash or Danger 500 and capitation fee.	Refer Family or Family+
Nipper (Starfish) 6 years to young adult with special needs. Competition fees not included. No voting rights. Access to club facilities, equipment, specialised fitness training & subsidised award training. Includes Nipper Pack, entry to either the Junior Juc Bash or Danger 500 and capitation fee. Family Includes one adult & one dependent (U21 as at 30-09-21). Adult has same rights and obligations as an Associate or Senior membership category. Dependent has same rights and obligations as their associated membership category.	\$210

Carnival Entry (Due 7 days prior to specified event - late entry fees can apply) Provides entry to a single, specified event, includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Junior, Senior and Masters carnivals • Surf, Pool, IRB and ASRL carnivals • Victorian and interstate carnivals • Pool, IRB, ASRL and Endurance Championships Excludes (but not limited to) Victorian and Australian Surf Lifesaving Championships. Senior competitors must have a minimum of 16 hours patrol prior to competition, and qualify/requalify for the appropriate awards.	Entry Fee + \$2
Victorian Surf Rowers League (VSRL) Registration (Due 7 days prior to first VSRL event) Provides ASRL & VSRL Membership, race singlet, hat and entry to all VSRL Carnivals	Reg Fee
Victorian Surf Lifesaving Championships (Due 14 days prior to event – late entry fees can apply) Provides a team uniform and entry to Victorian Surf Lifesaving Championships, includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Junior, Senior & Masters Championships • Lifesaver Event Championships 	Entry Fee + \$40
Australian Championships (Due 14 days prior to event – early bird and late entry fees can apply) Provides a team uniform and entry to Australian Surf Lifesaving Championships, includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Youth, Senior & Masters Championships 	Entry Fee + \$30
Competition Cap Mandatory for all Nippers during training and for all entrants and handlers at competitions.	\$15
Hi Vis Rash Vest (singlet) Mandatory for all competitors. Nippers must train in an approved colour Hi Vis rash vest.	\$25
Bronze Medallion Course (due 14 days prior to commencing course) Designed for adults, however minimum age is 15yo. You will need to commit to at least 32 hours of time plus assessment. There is a degree of flexibility in this course, with some theory to be finished at home. Prerequisite is a timed 400m pool swim in 9 minutes.	TBA
Bronze Medallion Camp (due 14 days prior to commencing course) A live-in camp designed for 15 to 17 year olds. Prerequisite is a timed 400m pool swim in 9 minutes.	TBA
Surf Rescue Certificate (due 14 days prior to commencing course) For 13-14yo members wishing to become Cadets. This award qualifies candidates for water safety and Age Group Assistants, along with supervised patrolling. Prerequisite is a timed 200m pool swim in 5 minutes. Pool squad training in Term 4 is recommended.	TBA
